# MASTER OF ARTS ORGANIZATIONAL LEADERSHIP



# APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

**Option 1:** GPA of at least 3.0 for the most recent 60 credits of undergraduate work.

**Option 2:** GPA between 2.5 and 2.99 for the most recent 60 credits of undergraduate work, plus an online preparatory course or courses as determined by the Registrar.

Option 3: A previous graduate degree.

**Option 4:** A portfolio of work demonstrating adequate preparation for rigorous graduate-level study.

Prospective students are encouraged to enhance their applications with additional materials such as GMAT or GRE scores, letter of recommendation, current resume, and/or a personal essay.

# PREREQUISITE COURSES

One college course each in Economics and Statistics. USK will grant conditional acceptance to students lacking these qualifications and offer affordable, time-sensitive options for attaining them.
